

2. The Head Office of the Trust shall be RCE-109, Bahadurpur Housing Colony, Post Office Road, Kankarbagh, Patna-800026, Bihar, and the address may be changed as and when found necessary by the Trustees. Trust can open its branch office any where as and when found necessary by the trustee.

#### The objects of the Trust shall be any or all of the following: 3.

- Advancement and propagation of education and learning (a) including establishment, maintenance and support of educational institutions.

the Trustees from time to time to frame such rules and regulations for the management and administration of the Trust and charities as they deem fit and to alter or vary the same from time to time to make new rules and regulations provided such rules and regulations shall not be inconsistent with the terms and intents of these presents and not inconsistent with the provisions of Sections 2 (15), 11 to 13 and 80-C of the Income-tax Act, 1961.

- (b) The Trustees shall meet as often as possible but not less than six times in a year for efficient management of the Trust, to consider the income and expenditure and for disposing of all such other matters as may arise in such meetings.
- (c) The trustee can take loan from any financial institution to meet out the objective of the trust.

### 6. POWER OF TRUSTEES:
